



MICHAEL BURNS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Michael Burns Memorial Scholarship was established in his memory by his parents Marjorie and Terry Burns. This scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating Clarinda High School (CHS) Senior that plans to attend Iowa State University (ISU) in the fall of the current year the scholarship is awarded.

Michael John Burns was a 1999 graduate of Clarinda High School. He attended Iowa State University where he graduated in 2003 with a double major in Marketing and Transportation & Logistics. At the time of his death he was an Implementation Consultant in the transportation business.

Michael's parents Marjorie and Terry Burns and his brother Matthew Burns were also CHS and ISU graduates.

The following guidelines will be used in making the scholarship selection:

1. The scholarship shall be used to help pay the cost of tuition for the recipient at Iowa State University (ISU).
2. The Clarinda Foundation shall disburse the scholarship grant to ISU for the recipient in one payment prior to the beginning of the fall semester of year in which the scholarship is awarded.

3. The selection committee shall consist of a minimum of four individuals: 1) one individual named by the Foundation (who shall serve as chair of the Committee); 2) the Clarinda High School (CHS) Principal, 3) the CHS Guidance Counselor, and 4) one CHS faculty member.
4. The selection committee reserves the right to not award the scholarship should they determine that no applicant is worthy.
5. The application must be typed or computer generated and shall include an essay addressing the following:
 - a. Applicant's intended major and why the applicant has chosen this major.
 - b. Applicant's contributions to the Clarinda High School and the community.
 - c. Applicant's work history.
 - d. Applicant's extracurricular activities.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded without regard to race, color, creed, gender, nationality, origin or physical handicap.
