Curriculum

The school day is made up of six periods with 60 minutes of instructional time per period.

Grading System

Clarinda High School uses a standard letter grading system as follows:

All grades are included in the computation of the GPA with the exception of physical education courses. Cumulative grade point averages are kept with a 4-point system. Class rank is cumulative and figured at the end of each trimester.

Traditionally, the Carnegie Unit reflects a student's seat time as a portion of ~ 7200 minutes. Clarinda High School classes meet for 60 minutes each day for each of our 60-day minimum trimesters. This calculates to 7200 minutes—well over the required number of minutes for seat time.

For example, a student takes Anatomy & Physiology A for one trimester, Anatomy & Phys B for a second trimester and Anatomy & Phys C for a third trimester. This calculates to one and a half Carnegie units worth of seat time within that three-trimester time

(One credit = one trimester/semester of work)
