

**October 6, 2010  
Special Meeting  
Board of Directors  
Clarinda Community School District**

The Board of Directors of the Clarinda Community School District met in special session on Wednesday, October 6, 2010, 5:30 p.m., at the boardroom located in the McKinley Building, 423 East Nodaway, Clarinda, IA 51632.

**Call to Order**

President Turner called the special meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

**Roll Call**

The following board members were present: President Turner, Vice President Fine, McComb, Rarick, and Watkins.

**Approval of Agenda**

A motion was made by Watkins, seconded by Rarick, to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

**Closed Session**

A motion was made by Fine, seconded by McComb, to conduct a hearing to consider disciplinary action against a student pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5 (1)(e) and to review and discuss records which are required by state or federal law to be maintained confidentially pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(a). A roll call vote provided the following: Turner-aye, McComb-aye, Fine-aye, Watkins-aye, and Rarick-aye. The motion passed on a unanimous vote and the board entered closed session at 5:37 p.m.

**Open Session**

President Turner declared the board out of closed session at 6:24 p.m.

**Decision Regarding Hearings**

A motion was made by Rarick, seconded by Fine, that

1. T.H. is prohibited from riding the school bus for the remainder of the 2010-2011 school year. In addition, he must pay for the repair of the damaged bus seat.
2. Due to this being a knife incident, T.H. is suspended from participating in or attending Clarinda School events for the remainder of the 2010-2011 school year. T.H. will only be allowed on Clarinda School property when accompanied by a parent.
3. T.H. will be required to submit a record of his academic performance, behavioral records and a letter requesting reinstatement of eligibility to the board for transportation and/or attendance in Clarinda Community Schools before he be readmitted in good standing with the district.
4. The board secretary will prepare a written decision including findings of fact and conclusions consistent with the board's decision, and
5. The board president or designee is authorized to review and sign the written decision.

A roll call vote was taken on the motion: McComb-aye, Fine-aye, Watkins-aye, Rarick-aye, and Turner-aye. Motion carried 5-0.

**Adjournment**

A motion was made by Fine, seconded by McComb, to adjourn the meeting at 6:34 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
