



Fall Guidance for Athletic/Activities Attendance CLARINDA COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

General Spectator Information:

- Facial coverings are required for all students and adults attending home games/events.
- All spectators will physically distance (6ft apart individually or in family units).
- 9th-12th grade students sitting in the stands will be required to stand on marked dots.
- Spectators will need to follow local home event-expectations for seating based on each facility in the Hawkeye 10 Conference.
- Children/students in 8th grade and under will not be admitted to games/events unless accompanied by an adult family member. Upon entering the facility, children/students in 8th grade and under are required to sit with parents.
- Spectators are asked to do all personal health screenings at home. If you are sick, please stay home.
- The PA announcer will provide frequent reminders for spectator guidance before and during the game/event.
- All home games/events will be livestreamed (Visit Clarinda Cardinal Youtube Channel - <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCNfzQ3zhruBstKMo1ea5QNg>).

Admissions:

- Event entrances may be modified depending on the event and venue.
- Activity pass purchases are highly encouraged to reduce cash transactions.
- If cash is used, the exact amount is highly recommended.
- Admission workers will be required to wear a mask if not behind a plexiglass barrier.
- Social distancing will be required in line. Please adhere to all posted signage.
- Digital Programs will be used through the Varsity Bound App (Directions are located on the CCSD Activities Home Page on the school district website - <https://www.clarinda.k12.ia.us/>).

Concessions:

- Exact cash amount is highly recommended when ordering from the concession stand.
- Social distancing will be required in line. Please adhere to all posted signage.
- Modifications will be made to the setup of the concessions stand to ensure safety.
- Concession stand workers will go through a health screening and wear face coverings and gloves when contacting food and throughout the game/event.

Media/Event Workers:

- Face coverings are required of all event staff and workers.
- Media must maintain 6 feet of distance when interviewing coaches and students and are required to wear facial coverings.

Important Things to Remember

- Wear a facial covering.
- Practice frequent hand washing.
- Monitor your health. If you feel sick, stay home!
- Remain Physically Distanced (6 feet apart individually or in family units).
- Avoid Face Touching.

**Failure to comply with these rules could result
in limiting or removal of spectators or from school game/events.**
