Eligibility Guidelines

This year, Page County Farm Bureau will provide two \$500 scholarships to students pursuing a degree from a 4-year college/university, community college or technical program.

To be eligible for this scholarship:

1. You must be a son or daughter of a Page County Farm Bureau member, or an adult member yourself.
2. You must be entering college for the first time.
3. You must be a high school graduate or expect to graduate in the spring of 2020.
4. High School GPA minimum of 2.5 and an ACT score of 18 or higher is necessary to qualify.
5. Scholarship is not renewable. It is payable at the beginning of the second semester of school following proof of first semester 2.0 minimum grade average (on a 4.0 grading scale) and proof of enrollment in school. It will be paid to the school on your behalf.
6. Scholarship funds can be used for tuition, books, room and board, or lab fees.

Scholarship application deadline is February 28, 2020.
