Eligibility Guidelines

This year, Page County Farm Bureau will provide two <u>\$500</u> scholarships to students pursuing a degree from a 4-year college/university, community college or technical program.

To be eligible for this scholarship:

- You must be a son or daughter of a Page County Farm Bureau member, or an adult member yourself.
- 2. You must be entering college for the first time.
- 3. You must be a high school graduate or expect to graduate in the spring of 2020.
- 4. High School GPA minimum of 2.5 and an ACT score of 18 or higher is necessary to qualify.
- 5. Scholarship is not renewable. It is payable at the beginning of the second semester of school following proof of first semester 2.0 minimum grade average (on a 4.0 grading scale) and proof of enrollment in school. It will be paid to the school on your behalf.
- 6. Scholarship funds can be used for tuition, books, room and board, or lab fees.

Scholarship application deadline is February 28, 2020.
