

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete the courses required by the board and Iowa Department of Education in order to graduate.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent to ensure students complete grades one through twelve and that high school students in classes of 2020 complete 48 credits prior to graduation and classes of 2021, 2022 and 2023 complete 52 credits prior to graduation.
