Scheduling

- Back to school night virtual tour is planned for now
- Elementary schedules
 - Keep bubble of students in place.
 - Provide interventions in classrooms.
 - Teachers move to meet the need of the children.
- 7th-12th Scheduling of classes
 - Will take place through JMC student accounts
 - This will happen In the coming weeks.
 - 9-12th will receive email to select courses they are interested in taking this week.
- Transportation
 - Director and Bus Drivers consolidated routes
 - Bus Drivers are calling all families to introduce themselves
 - Bus Drivers will collect data on routes and number of students that will be riding busses
- Movement in the Building
 - Flow of hallways
 - Signage and visuals of direction of movements

Shared Materials/Areas







- Professional development will be provided to staff regarding the recommendations for wiping down materials.
- A routine/schedule will be established for wiping down materials and areas with the recommended alcohol content.
- A protocol will be established where students will not share classroom materials.
- All student materials will be individual and limited.
 - Unlawful to share supplies. Each child will use the supplies she/he brings.
 - School will help provide materials to students who are in need.
 - No stuffed animals,

- Band No shared instruments

Elementary

- All 1st -6 students will be dropped off/picked up at the south doors (circle drive).
- All K-6 students riding the bus will be dropped off/pickup at the west doors.
- All PK students will be dropped off and picked up at the north doors.

7th-12th Building

- Bus pick up/drop off on the east side of the building
- Parent pick up/drop off on the west side of the building
- HS student parking on the north side of the building.


