

Date	Deadline
June 30, 2024	Any application filed on or before June 30, 2024 will not require good cause for waiving the March 1 deadline. The receiving district may accept open enrollment applications for the 2023-2024 or 2024-2025 school year without approval from the resident school district.
July 1, 2024	Senate File 2435 takes effect. Applications for <u>students grades 1 – 12</u> will be denied unless the parent or guardian is able to demonstrate good cause.
September 1 (of the current school year the student enrolls)	Application deadline for <u>incoming preschool students who receive special education services requiring specially designed instruction (SDI)</u> to open enroll for the current school year.
September 1 (of the current school year the student enrolls)	Application deadline for <u>incoming kindergarten students</u> to open enroll for the current school year.
September 2 (of the current school year the student enrolls)	Applications for <u>incoming preschool students requiring SDI and kindergarten students</u> will be denied unless the parent or guardian is able to demonstrate “good cause” (see the following “Good Cause” Exemptions to Deadlines section).
March 1 (of the preceding school year)	Application deadline for students in grades 1-12 to open enroll for the upcoming school year.
March 2 (of the preceding school year)	Applications for students grades 1-12 will be denied unless the parent or guardian is able to demonstrate good cause.
